

PRE-VERBAL AFFIXES IN KİMWİMBİ

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Prefixes are affixes that occur before the root. They confer upon the verb meanings that have to do with focus, grammatical person, tense and aspect, modality and negation and condition. This poster presents all the prefixes that precede the macrostem, as well as the object marker that is part of the macrostem in Kîmwîmbî, in an order from the ones in verb initial position to the ones coming immediately before the macrostem.

1. THE FOCUS MARKER

The focus marker in Kîmwîmbî takes the form n̄- and it may occur clause-initially for subjects and for objects thus:

a. N̄i Njoki akaruga.
N̄i Njoki a- ka-rug- a.
Fm 1.Njoki sm1-fut-cook-fv
It's Njoki who will cook.

b. Ni mûcere Njoki akaruga.
Ni mûcere Njoki a- ka-rug- a
Fm 3.rice 1.Njoki sm1-fut-cook-fv
I t's rice that Njoki will cook.

In wh-interrogatives in Kîmwîmbî the focus marker is pronominalized before the wh-word.

N̄i mbi Njeri akaruga?
N̄i mbi Njeri a- ka-rug- a
Fm what 1.Njeri sm1-fut-cook-fv
What will Njeri cook?

2. MODAL PARTICLE

- a. Ga/Ka : Supplies an affirmative reading
Nîkambîfîte.
N̄i- ka- mb- t̄j- t̄t- e.
Fm-mod-1sg-come-pft-fv
I am coming.
- b. -batî: denotes strong advice
Nyaga nîbatî kûthi Nairobi rû.
Nyaga n̄i a- batî kû- thi Nairobi rû.
1.Nyaga fm sm1-mod ncp15-go Nairobi tomorrow
Nyaga ought to go to Nairobi tomorrow.
- c. Ethwa: Conveys the equivalent of used to in English:
Njeri nîethwa aringîte.
Njeri n̄i a- ith- ag- w- a a- ring-ît- e
1.Njeri fm-sm1-mod-hab-psv-fv sm1-call-pft-fv
Njeri has usually called (by that time)
- d. Amba: conveys the meaning "you should first" do X before doing Y
N̄i ambe athi Nairobi.
N̄i ambe a- thi Nairobi
Fm mod sm1-go Nairobi
Let him/her go to Nairobi first.
- e. /No: confers three readings upon a verb:

i: possibility.
Nyaga no athi Nairobi rû.
Nyaga no a- thi Nairobi rû
1.Nyaga mod sm1-go Nairobi tomorrow
Nyaga might go to Nairobi tomorrow

ii: eventuality
Nyaga no akathi Nairobi rû.
Nyaga no a- ka-thi Nairobi rû
1.Nyaga mod sm1-fut-go Nairobi tomorrow
Nyaga will eventually go to Nairobi

iii: compulsion
Nyaga no athire Nairobi.
Nyaga no a- thi- ir- e Nairobi
1.Nyaga mod sm1-go-perf-fv Nairobi
Nyaga must go to Nairobi.

f. /O: occurs in mutual exclusion with the focus marker
It conveys three readings on the verb

i. Possibility
Nyaga to athi Nairobi rû?

Nyaga to a- thi Nairobi rû
1.Nyaga mod sm1-go Nairobi tomorrow

Might Nyaga not go to Nairobi tomorrow?

ii. Seeking confirmation of an eventuality
Nyaga to athire Nairobi rû?

Nyaga to a- thi- ir- e Nairobi rû
1.Nyaga mod sm1-go-perf-fv Nairobi tomorrow

Isn't it a must that Nyaga will go to Nairobi tomorrow?

iii. Emphasising the obligation
Nyaga to athîte Nairobi rû?

Nyaga to a- thi-ir- e Nairobi rû
1.Nyaga mod sm-go-pft-fv Nairobi tomorrow

Isn't Nyaga still going to Nairobi tomorrow?

g. Mwanka

Carries the reading of compulsion. It is usually preceded by no or to discussed above to emphasise or negate the compulsion respectively.

No mwanka Nyaga athi Nairobi rû.

No mwanka Nyaga a- thi Nairobi rû

Mod mod 1.Nyaga sm1-go Nairobi tomorrow

Nyaga must go to Nairobi tomorrow.

To mwanka Nyaga athi Nairobi rû.

To mwanka Nyaga a- thi Nairobi rû

Mod mod 1.Nyaga sm1-go Nairobi tomorrow

Nyaga does not have to go to Nairobi tomorrow.

h. Umba confers the reading of possibility

Nyaga aûumba kûthi Nairobi rû.

Nyaga a- ûumba kû- thi Nairobi rû
1.Nyaga sm1-mod ncp15-go Nairobi tomorrow

We might go to Nairobi tomorrow.

i. Tiga: Confers three meanings on a verb

i. let me

Tiga mbîje nau ūrî.

Tiga mb- t̄j- e nau ū- rî

Mod 1sg-come-fv there 1sg-be

Let me come where you are

ii. were it not for

Tiga atûk-a tûringimwona.

Tiga a- ûk- a tû- tî- ngî-mu- on- a

Mod sm1-come-fv 2pl-neg-con-on-1-see-fv

Were it not that he/she has come we would not have seen him/her.

iii. unless:

Tûringimwona tiga tûmûringîre thimû mbere.

Tû- tî- mu- on- a tiga tû-mû- ring- t̄- e thimû mbere

2pl-neg-on-1-see-fv mod 2pl-om1-call-appl-fv 9.phone first

We won't see him/her unless we call him/her first.

4. THE NEGATIVE MORPHEME

Negates the proposition

Nyaga atîgûra mügûnda.

Nyaga a- tî- gûr- a mügûnda

1.Nyaga sm1-neg-buy- fv land

Nyaga won't buy land

5. THE CONDITION-MARKER MORPHEME

Aringîringa thimû kethwa....

A- rî- ngî-ring- a thimû kethwa....

Sm1-wp- con-call-fv 9.phone if

7. THE REMOTE FUTURE/NEVER MORPHEME

Tûkaroina ndwimbo jia kwendia.

Tû- ka- ro- in- a ndwimbo jia ku-end-i-a

1pl-fut- rf- sing- fv 11.songs for ncp15-sell-tr-fv

We will sing songs for sale at one time (in the future.)

6. TENSE AFFIXES

a. The Present Tense

Kaaria nîakûrim-a.

Kaaria nî- a- kû- rim- a

1.Kaaria fm-sm1-cur-weed-fv

Kaaria is weeding

b. The Past Tense

Mwangi nîarainaga.

Mwangi nî- a- ra- in- ag- a

1.Mwangi fm-sm1-np-dance-cont-fv

Mwangi was dancing (before today, but recently)

c. The Future

Mwangi nîakaina.

Mwangi nî- a- ka-in-a



1.Mwangi fm-sm1-rf-dance-fv

Mwangi will dance (some time after today).

1.Mutugi fm-sm1-om1-call-call- hab-appl-fv

9.phone 9.day this

Mütugi calls him/her from time to time nowadays.
